Opening the test

Enter your keycode

Confirm your details

You will then be asked to confirm your name and test name.

If these are correct, click **Yes**.

You will then be asked to confirm your details are correct and agree to the code of conduct of the assessment by ticking the box and selecting **Continue**.

Enter your PIN

Enter the PIN you have been given. (This is the **shorter** of the two codes you have been given.)

Click **Enter**.

Introduction and preferences

You will now see an introduction page.

In the bottom left corner, there is a **'preferences'** button. Click on this if you would like to make some changes to how you view your test. You can change the background colour, the font colour, and the contrast of the screen.

During the test

Working your way around

- Navigate through the test using the numbers on the left of the screen.
